Purpose

Use this worksheet to move from first impression to systems analysis. The aim is not to decide whether Blue Current is “good” or “bad.” The aim is to ask: what system is this dive shop part of, and what pressures may it be helping reproduce?

1. First impression

At first sight, what makes Blue Current look credible, attractive, or responsible? Write down three things.

2. What pressures are beginning to show?

Even if the reef still looks beautiful, what warning signs suggest that pressure may be building? List at least three signs you noticed in the case.

Optional: What might a casual guest fail to notice?

3. Use the six lenses

Look at the case again through these six lenses. For each one, note one important observation.

Ecology What signs relate to reef condition, coral structure, fish life, resilience, or fragility? <hr/> <hr/>	Tourism use What signs relate to site use, diver numbers, frequency, or operating patterns? <hr/> <hr/>
Waste & infrastructure What hidden infrastructure pressures may be shaping reef health? <hr/>	Livelihoods Who appears to benefit from this tourism model? Who may become vulnerable if conditions change? <hr/>
